In accordance with the fiscal year (FY) 2001 Energy and Water Development Appropriations Conference Report (106-988), the FY 2002 Energy and Water Development Appropriations Conference Report (107-258), and Section 3136(b) (1) of the FY 1997 National Defense Authorization Act, enclosed is the FY 2003 report on Laboratory Directed Research and Development (LDRD). The report also includes information on the Department's Plant Directed Research, Development, and Demonstration (PDRD) and Site Directed Research, Development, and Demonstration (SDRD) programs as well.

The report reflects a new streamlined format as recommended in the Conference Report (108-357) accompanying the FY 2004 Energy and Water Development Appropriations Act and provides information on program expenditures by laboratory, weapons production plant and site for 1,789 projects expending more than \$380 million during FY 2003. The report also delineates procedures implemented to provide assurance that all LDRD activities derived from funds of other Federal agencies have been conducted in a manner that supports science and technology development, that benefit the programs of the sponsoring agencies, and that are consistent with the appropriation acts that provided funds to those agencies.

This report also fulfills the mandate of the National Defense Authorization Act of FY 1997, which requires an assessment of the extent to which LDRD activities support the national security mission of the Department. The information provided in the report demonstrates how the LDRD program supports the national security mission of the Department and provides an analysis that indicates the LDRD benefits are commensurate with the funding received from defense and non-defense sources.
